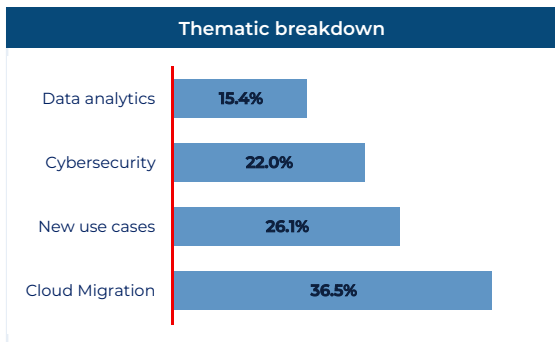
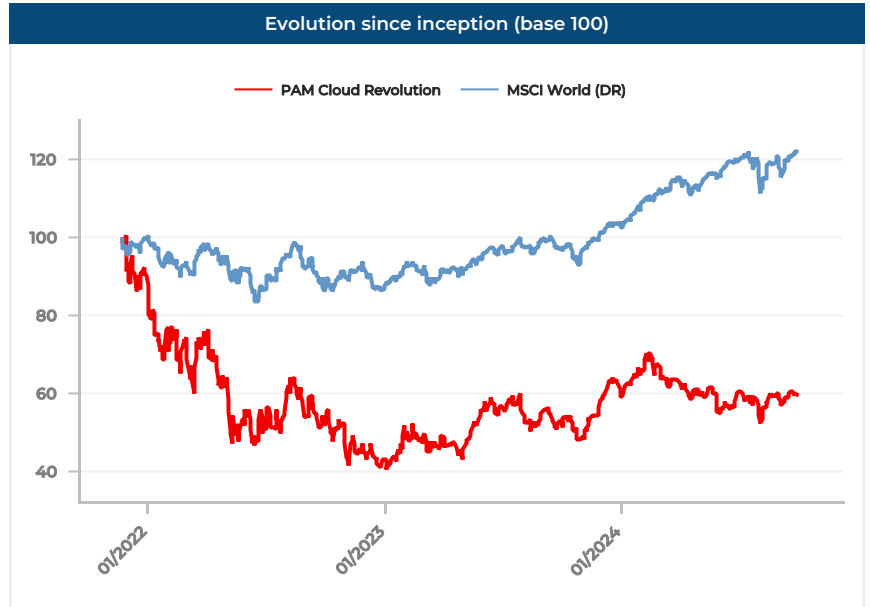


Pléiade AM is an independent asset manager specialised in mutual funds, with a “stock picking” approach.

This is a unique configuration, focused on hyper-growth, which has allowed the emergence of new leaders, driven by a structural transformation of the economy.

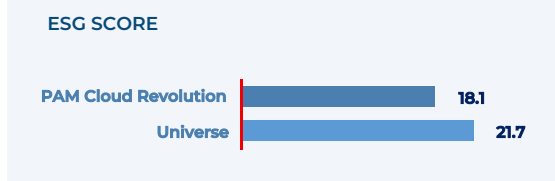

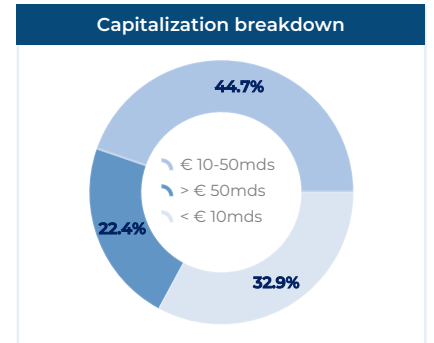
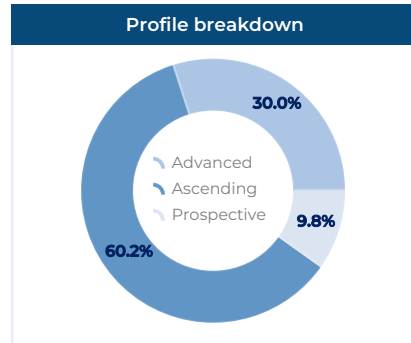
